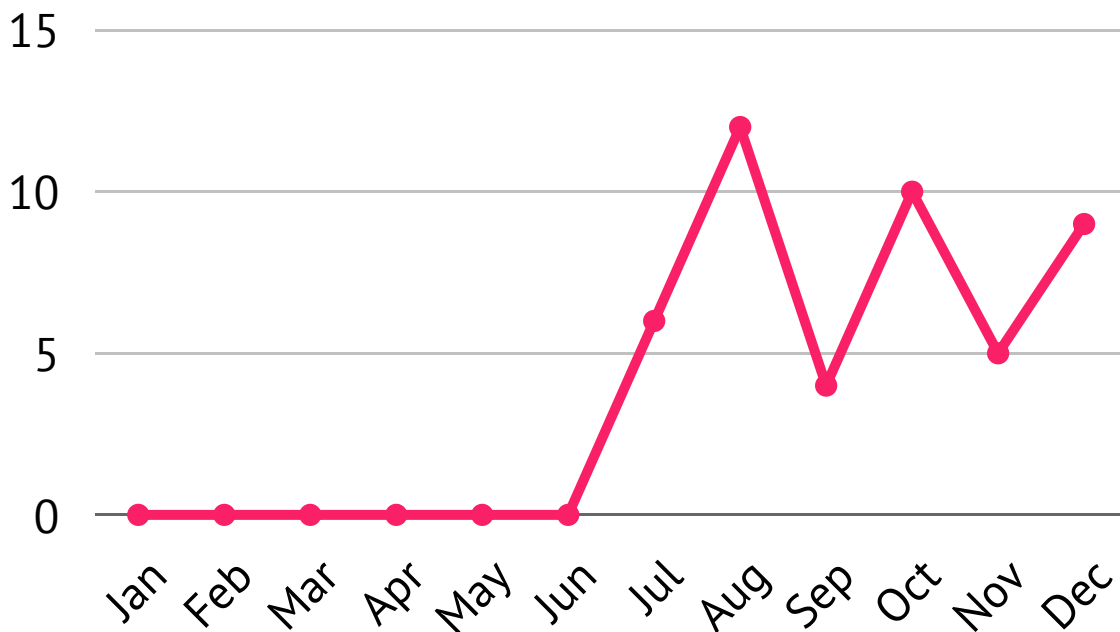

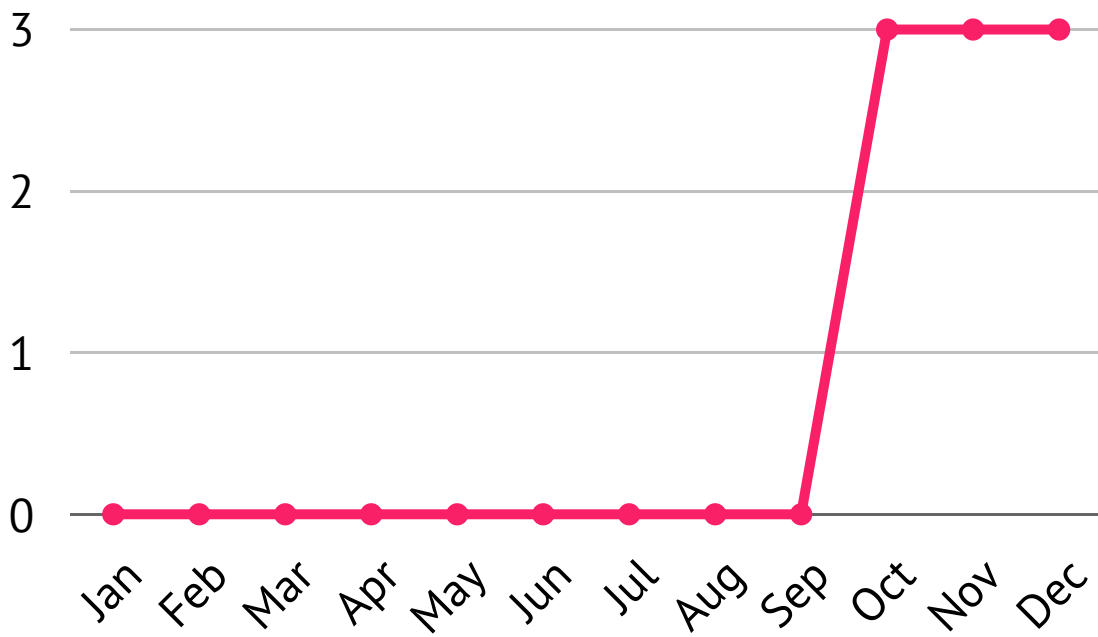
2021 HIGHLIGHTS

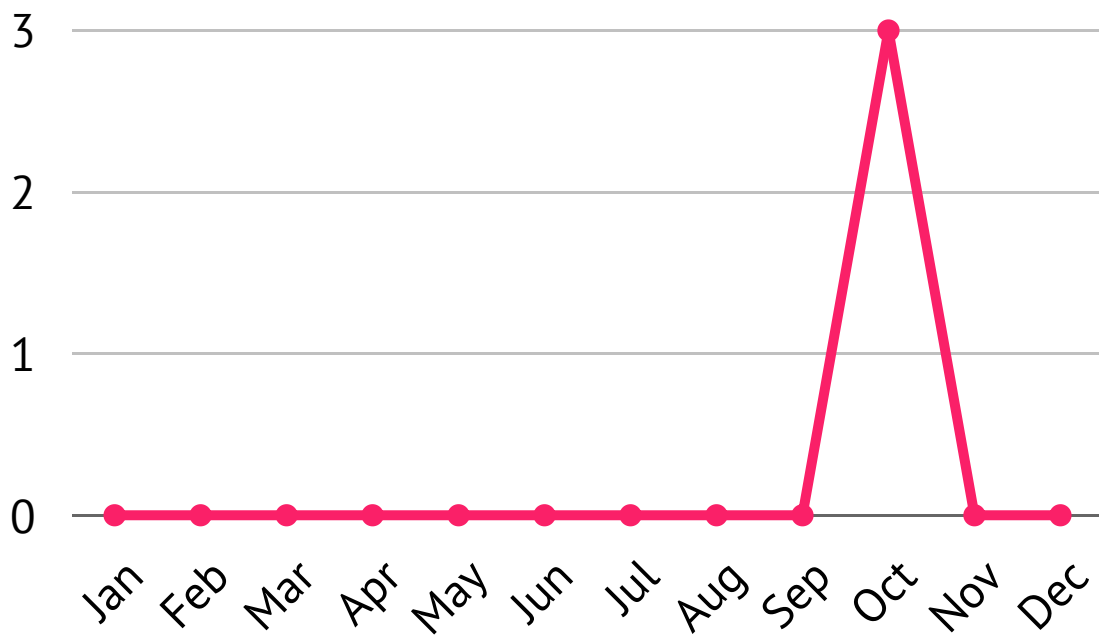

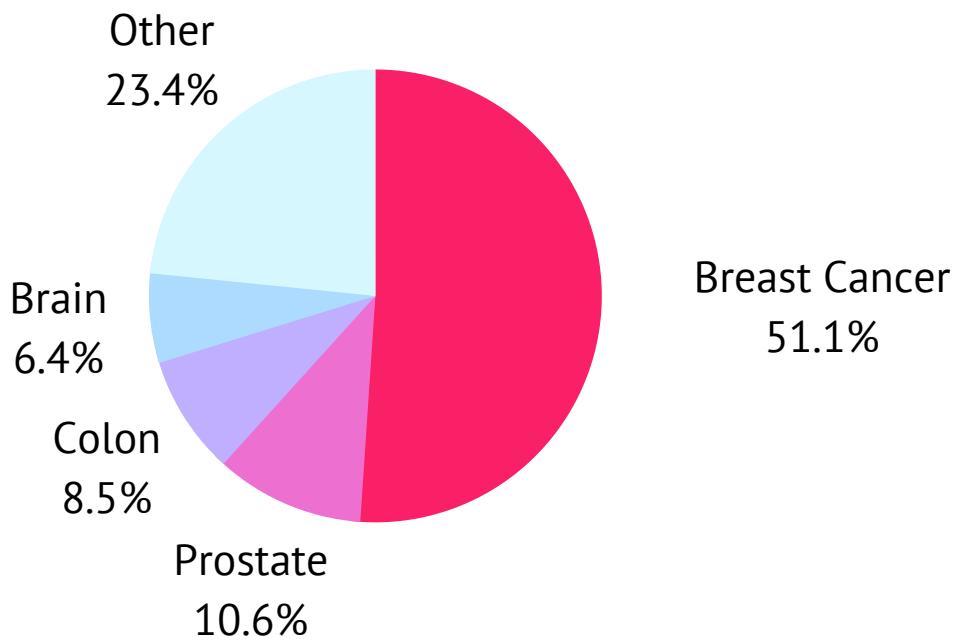

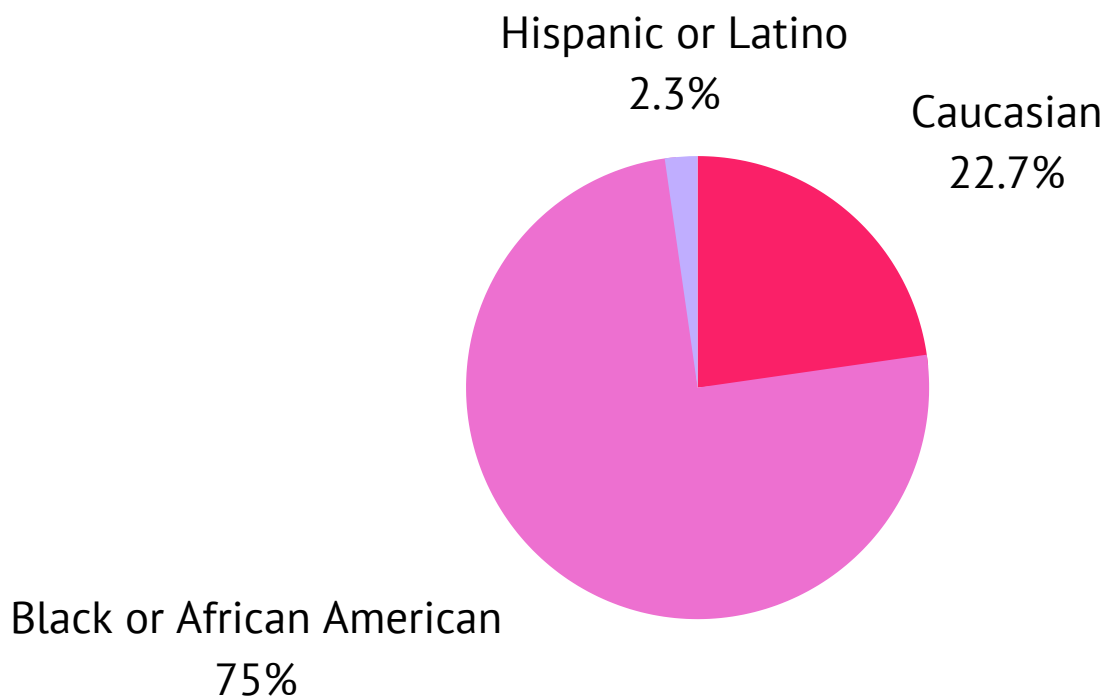

TYPES OF CANCERS



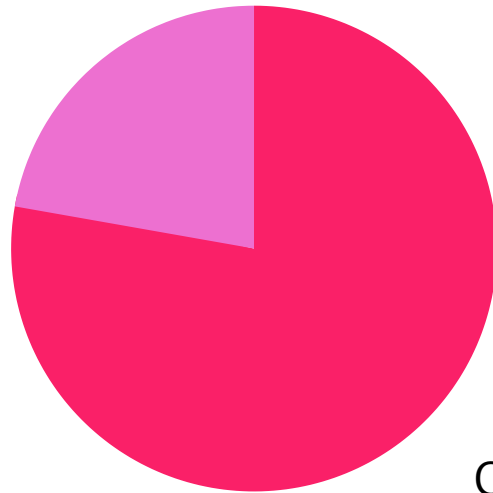
RACE OR ETHNICITY FOR CARE BOX INITIATIVE

Black or African American

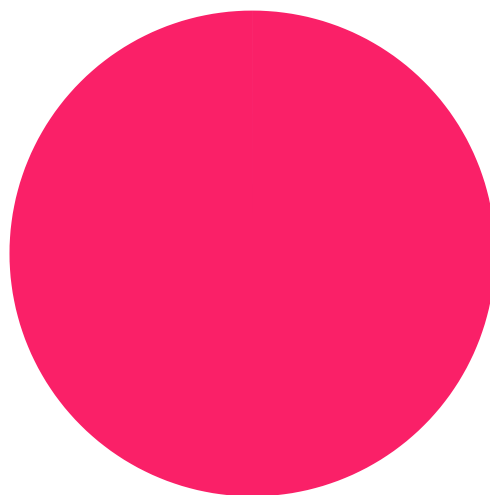

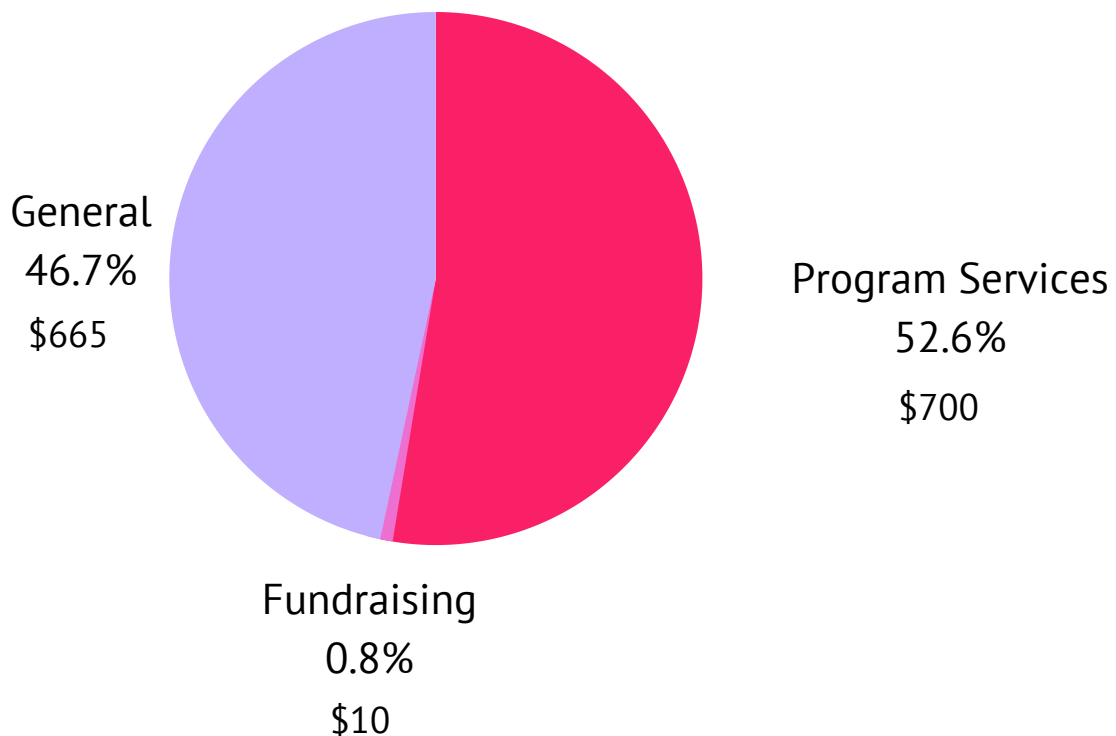


2021 EXPENSES
